We are called to be disciples, to follow Jesus with our whole heart, soul and mind and then to share what we have found with all those we meet. Let us ask our Lord to set our hearts on fire with love for Him and that others may come to know him through us.

Children Welcome Here!

To the parents of young children, may we suggest...

- Relax! The Lord put the wiggle in children, so don't feel you have to suppress it in His house. All are welcome!
- Sit toward the front where it is easier for your little ones to see and hear. They tire of looking at the backs of others' heads.
- Quietly explain the parts and actions of the Mass to them.
- Sing the hymns, pray and voice the responses. Children learn liturgical behavior by copying you.
- If you have to leave Mass with your child, feel free to so... but please come back! As Jesus said: "Let the children come to me" (Mt 19:14).

To the other members of our parish, some reminders...

- The presence of children is a gift to the Church. They give us "a future full of hope" (Jer 9:11).
- The way we welcome children directly affects the way they respond to God and to the Church. Let them know that they can be at home here.
- The parents of young children are doing a great (and sometimes difficult) thing by bringing their kids to Mass. Give them a smile and a word of encouragement

From Fr. Tom... At the annual Chrism Mass back in April, Bishop LaValley announced that the Roman Catholic Diocese of Ogdensburg was entering into a "twinning" relationship with the Maronite Catholic Diocese of Lattakia in Syria. The Christian faith is under harsh attack in the Middle East and in danger of dying out in the very region where it first began. So our Bishop is calling the people of the North Country into a "solidarity of faith" with our suffering brothers and sisters out of the belief that we have both much to give and much to receive in such a relationship with a diocese very different from our own. Dear Friends in Christ:

Missionary zeal has always been a telling sign of the vitality of the Catholic Church. The annual collection for the **Missionary Projects of the Diocese of Ogdensburg (MPDO)** offers the opportunity to further our own passion in supporting the ministry of our missionaries who serve so faithfully in often forgotten places in our world.

During the weekend Masses of July 29th and 30th, the parishioners of Franklin, Clinton, Adirondack, Essex and Hamilton-Herkimer Deaneries will be given an opportunity to support our missionaries. This year, our focus turns to the Diocese of Lattakia in Syria where we continue our twinning initiative. Located on the shores of the Mediterranean Sea, Lattakia is home to the oldest Christian settlements on earth. They are experiencing a large influx of refugees which has doubled their relief efforts but depleted their resources to do so effectively. Our "*Solidarity in Faith*" endeavor will provide concrete ways for the faithful of our Diocese to learn about Lattakia while supporting their relief programs and furthering pastoral goals like catechism for children and adults, formation programs, and marriage preparation. Our parishes will offer prayers and sacrifices for the Diocese of Lattakia as we emphasize relationships over resources, practice mutuality and equality, seek to give and receive, while we learn about the strong faith of the Church in the Middle East.

The **Missionary Projects of the Diocese of Ogdensburg Appeal** will also continue to be used to provide financial support of our former mission in Mollendo, Peru, support the United States Bishops' annual Appeal for Latin America, and assist other missionary projects throughout the world as part of our evangelization efforts.

I am very grateful for your gift to this year's **MPDO Appeal**. God bless you for your generous support of the Church's missionary efforts.
